MCRC VOTER ROLL CLEANUP PROJECT

MCRC First Vice Chair Shelby Busch has announced that the MCRC is ready to begin training for Managers for the Voter Roll Cleanup Project.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED! We need volunteers for two positions for this project: LD8 Manager and Investigators. Please contact LD8 Chair Ray Michaels for more details or if you are interested in either of these roles:

Managers MUST know:

A. Any problems with an investigator should be discussed with publicity team and NOT publicity.

- B. They will be tasked with assisting with on-boarding, assigning and verifying, the work of the teams investigators, attending weekly zoom meetings and providing monthly updates at their LDs.
- C. Monthly LD Reports are limited to the details they will be trained to release. **Investigators** MUST Know:
- A. They will be required to subscribe to a monthly background check service at \$24.00 a month. If they are unable to afford the subscription, they can ask for 'scholarship' and We will pay for the subscription for them as long as they are productive int the project.
- B. They need to have basic computer skills
- C. They must have analytical decision making skills
- D. Their work will be reviewed by a manager and they may be asked to reassess a disposition
- E. Access will be carefully monitored and any violations of usage will result in project termination

Election Workers needed for March PPE Election

Maricopa County America First Patriots must volunteer as Election Workers. Election Workers are paid by the county and county training is required. Maricopa County will be hiring approximately 1500 poll workers and hiring process will begin early December and deadline for our volunteer submittal is December 21st. Marco County will also be hiring a few hundred MCTEC workers. If you volunteer for MCTEC, please be willing to work the entire voting month. Workers can make a difference, please sign up. We will add all your supplied information to the county required spreadsheet and then submit the spreadsheet to the county. The county will contact you for training and then assign you to a polling center or MCTEC.
