Tuesday, February 20 -Last day to register to vote Wednesday, February 21 -Early voting begins Friday, March 15 -Last day to vote in person Tuesday, March 19 -Election Day (Emergency)

Only voters registered with the Democratic or Republican parties by Tuesday, February 20 are eligible to vote for their preferred presidential candidate. All other voters, including those registered as Party Not Declared(PND), which includes Independents, cannot participate per state law.

Voters can check <u>https://elections.maricopa.gov/voting/voter-dashboard-login</u> to see their registration and party status, find election information, nearby election voting centers, as well as track ballot status in real-time.
