In addition to needing poll observers, we need people to serve in the below 6 critical areas. You can volunteer for more than one area and there will be new opportunities coming, including a mass canvassing effort in September.

CALL TO ACTION, PLEASE SIGN UP TO HELP IN AT LEAST ONE OF THESE SIX AREAS.

1. WAR ROOM VOTER ASSISTANCE HOTLINE

We fielded nearly 400 election day hotline calls on Primary Election Day. This Hotline will be marketed to the PCs, LDs, Voters and more for the general. We need people to man the hotline on the 29 days of the election. If you are able to assist, a signup genius will be provided to you for shifting. You will also need to be trained on election related laws and procedures and will need to learn how to operate the ticketing system, Training will be provided on multiple dates and Times. 2. PHONE BANK:

We will need people to volunteer and shift for phone banking projects. We will be calling registered voters for the upcoming election to assist voters with candidate information and to garner pledges for our candidates. Volunteers that sign up as part of their LD, will be assigned voters in their own LDs and we will track progress. We are looking to get every LD to participate 40 hours a week. This can be done with 10 volunteers a week working for 4 hours or 5 volunteers working 8 hours. **Phone Banks training will begin on Saturday August 24th @ 10:00 am at headquarters. We will start reaching out to phone bank volunteers this weekend.**

The phone banks are integrated with Voter Spectrum and the surveys will be preformatted. Each LD will receive periodic reports on numbers of voters contacted and the survey results.
